**The mom/dad and tots** class's goal is to orient children through an exploratory process. Parents/ caregivers observe and make art with their children and gain insight into the benefits of art making in early childhood development.

**Clay sculpture:** Learn about coil and slab construction, surface textures, sculpting. Students will use air-dry clay. Leave your masterpiece natural as it dries, or paint it with acrylic paint.

**Printmaking:** Create a variety of images and patterns with, stencils, stamps, block and transfer print techniques. Combine collage, painting, and printmaking to create richly textured imagery.

**Nature Sculpture:** Use various nature items including feathers, wood, paper, recyclable materials to construct 3-D works of art.
